## FOREST DEPARTMENT, MANIPUR WILD LIFE PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION- 2025

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- 1. The theme of the competition shall be "Wild Mammals of Manipur in their Natural Habitat"
- 2. There is no entry fee for the competition.
- 3. Competition is open to all irrespective of age, gender and profession.
- 4. The photograph must be solely taken from Manipur and must feature only the mammal species listed in the provided Annexure. Photograph of Rhesus monkey & photographs taken from the Zoological Gardens and similar captivities will not be allowed to enter in the competition and Fabricated, masqueraded and photographs downloaded either from the web or net without exif data will also be summarily rejected from the competition.
- 5. Only photographs taken between the advertisement date and 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 will be considered; those taken outside this period will be rejected.
- 6. A maximum of five different photographs per participant shall be allowed to enter in the competition and only one best photograph will be selected from amongst them. Photos shall be geotagged and with date. No geotagged photo will be entertained.
- 7. Name, address & any identification marks of the competitors should not be written on the photograph. However, English name, scientific name, local name & conservation status (if known) as per IUCN List with theme may be written on the right hand corner and back of the photograph. Specific topic once entered in the application form cannot be changed.
- 8. The specification of the resolution of the digital photographs should be at least 3872 pixel (wide) and 2592 pixel (height) with not less than 3 MB. Photographs without technical details such as ISO, aperture, speed etc will not be considered for the competition and it should be clearly mentioned in the back of the photographs.
- 9. The competitors must submit photographs in hard copy (size: 11.6 x 8.2 inches) to the office of concerned Divisional Forest Officer or direct to the email id: <u>acfwildlife.manipur@gmail.com</u> as soft copy either JPEG or TIFF on or before 5.00 pm of 1\* September 2025.
- 10. There will be a total of 100 marks for the competition to be judged by a panel of three judges/professional experts and weightage shall be as follows:

i) Specific topic of the Photograph : 10 Marks ii) Description of Photograph : 20 Marks

iii) Quality of the photograph : 40 Marks

iv) Conservation Status : 20 Marks

{Critically Endangered (CR)-20, Endangered (EN)/ Vulnerable (VU)/ Near Threatened (NT)-15 Marks, Data

Deficiency (DD)/Others-10 Marks}

v) Endemic : 05 Marks vi) New Record sighting : 05 Marks

Total: 100 Marks

- 11. The decision of the panel of judges will be final for the competitions and no complain will be entertained under any circumstances. The decision of the Forest Department shall be final and binding.
- 12. Department of Forest, Wild Life Wing, and Government of Manipur shall have the right to reproduce the photographs which have won the prizes in the Competition in any form without forfeiting the rights of the photographs as per the Copy Rights Act, 1957. The remaining photos shall be returned to the participants. In case, the Department wishes to use any photo that has not won any prize, a sum of Rs.4000/- per photo shall be paid to the photographer.
